BYOC

The CTL Bring Your Own Chromebook Parent Portal



Dear Parent, Welcome to the CTL BYOC (Bring Your Own Chromebook) program for RSM Christian School! Your School has worked with CTL to design a BYOC program just for your school. This program allows schools to set up standard Chromebook devices, configurations, and accessories for parents to purchase from at a discounted price.

FAQ

Q. Who is this program for?

A. 7th and 8th graders.

Q. Is this CTL BYOC program mandatory?

A. No. Parents are not required to purchase CTL Chromebooks through this BYOC program. However, Chromebooks not purchased through the program must meet the requirements outlined in the RSMSC Junior High BYOC requirements sheet.

Q. Is a case required?

A. A case is recommended but not required.

Q. Is there a purchasing discount?

A. Yes, RSMCS has negotiated a special discount for CTL BYOC purchases. On ctl.net, use the code from 6/4 ParentSquare post to apply the discount.

Q. Is there a specific Chromebook model or configuration that is required?

A. All CTL Chromebooks listed at <https://ctl.net/collections/chromebooks> comply with RSM Christian School's recommended specifications.

Q. Should I get an "Accidental Damage" warranty upgrade?

B. An Accidental Damage extended warranty is recommended, but not required. An accidental damage warranty covers repairs to your device if it is broken. If your device breaks, and has an accidental damage warranty, RSMCS will issue a loaner Chromebook to your child while your device is getting repaired.

1. Navigate to <https://ctl.net/collections/chromebooks>
2. Select a model, and choose whether to add a case, warranty extensions or any other optional add-ons or accessories (a Chrome Management License is not needed)
3. Add the device to your cart and proceed to checkout.
4. Enter the code from the 6/4 ParentSquare post into the "Discount code" box, and click "Apply"

All Chromebooks not purchased through CTL must meet the following specifications to be used at school:

Chromebook	A Chromebook is a laptop computer with an attached keyboard that runs on the ChromeOS operating system.
CPU	Intel® Celeron N4000 or better or; Intel® Braswell or Cherry Trail or; Intel® i3, i5, or i7; Rockchip RK3288
Hard Drive	32GB solid-state Most files will be stored in Google Drive
RAM	At least 4GB, preferably 8GB
Screen Size	11.50 to 13.5 inches - Keep in mind, the larger the screen, the heavier the device.
Battery Life	6 hr or longer Make sure it will get your student through an entire school day.
Wireless	Wireless N or AC (802.11N, 802.11AC)
USB Ports	at least one of the following - USB-A 3.0, USB-C 3.0
Display ports	at least one HDMI, mini HDMI, mini DisplayPort, or USB-C with DisplayPort or HDMI support
Audio ports	at least one Stereo headphone and microphone jack set OR one combination jack
ChromeOS Auto Update	Every Chromebook has an expiration date, after which, Google stops supporting the device. Auto Update policy must be valid for the current school year. If you are purchasing a new Chromebook, you should consult the Auto Update policy page to find the model's expiration date BEFORE purchasing as it is NOT based on the purchase date. https://support.google.com/chrome/a/answer/6220366
Weight	Around 3 lbs Your student will be carrying their device with them all day so take the weight of the device into consideration when purchasing a Chromebook.
Protective Case	A protective case is suggested for the safety of the device. Please consider the weight of the case as part of the overall weight your child will be carrying.
