Junior High Chromebook Requirements for the 2026–2027 School Year

All Junior High students are required to bring a **Chromebook** that meets the specifications below. No Windows laptops, MacBooks, iPads, or Devices running operating systems other than ChromeOS are permitted.

Chromebook	Must be a Chromebook running ChromeOS. Must have a physical keyboard (built-in or attached). Touchscreen and stylus support are not required.
Operating System	Must support ChromeOS version 131 or newer.
CPU	Intel N100, N150, N200, N250 or newer, or Intel Core i3 (8th generation or newer), or AMD Ryzen 3 (7000 series or newer), and equivalent or better
Hard Drive	32GB to 64GB solid-state drive
RAM	8GB RAM strongly recommended (4GB minimum)
Screen Size	Between 11.5" and 14" with a minimum screen resolution of 1024 × 768 Students carry their devices throughout the school day. Larger screens increase weight.
Battery Life	8 hr or longer The Chromebook battery must last a full school day without charging.
Wireless	Must support WiFi 5 802.11g (minimum), 802.11n, or 802.11ac (recommended)
USB Ports	One USB-C port and at least one additional USB-A or USB-C port
Display ports	HDMI or USB-C port with video output capability
Audio ports	Built-in speakers & microphone, and headphone jack or USB-C with audio support
ChromeOS Auto Update	Every Chromebook has an Auto Update Expiration (AUE) date. The AUE date is based on the model — NOT the purchase date. Must receive ChromeOS updates through at least June of the current school year. Devices that are past their AUE date will not be permitted. BEFORE purchasing a new or used Chromebook, verify the model's AUE here: https://support.google.com/chrome/a/answer/6220366
Weight	Recommended: Under 3.5 lbs (including case)
Protective Case	A durable, padded protective case is strongly recommended.
